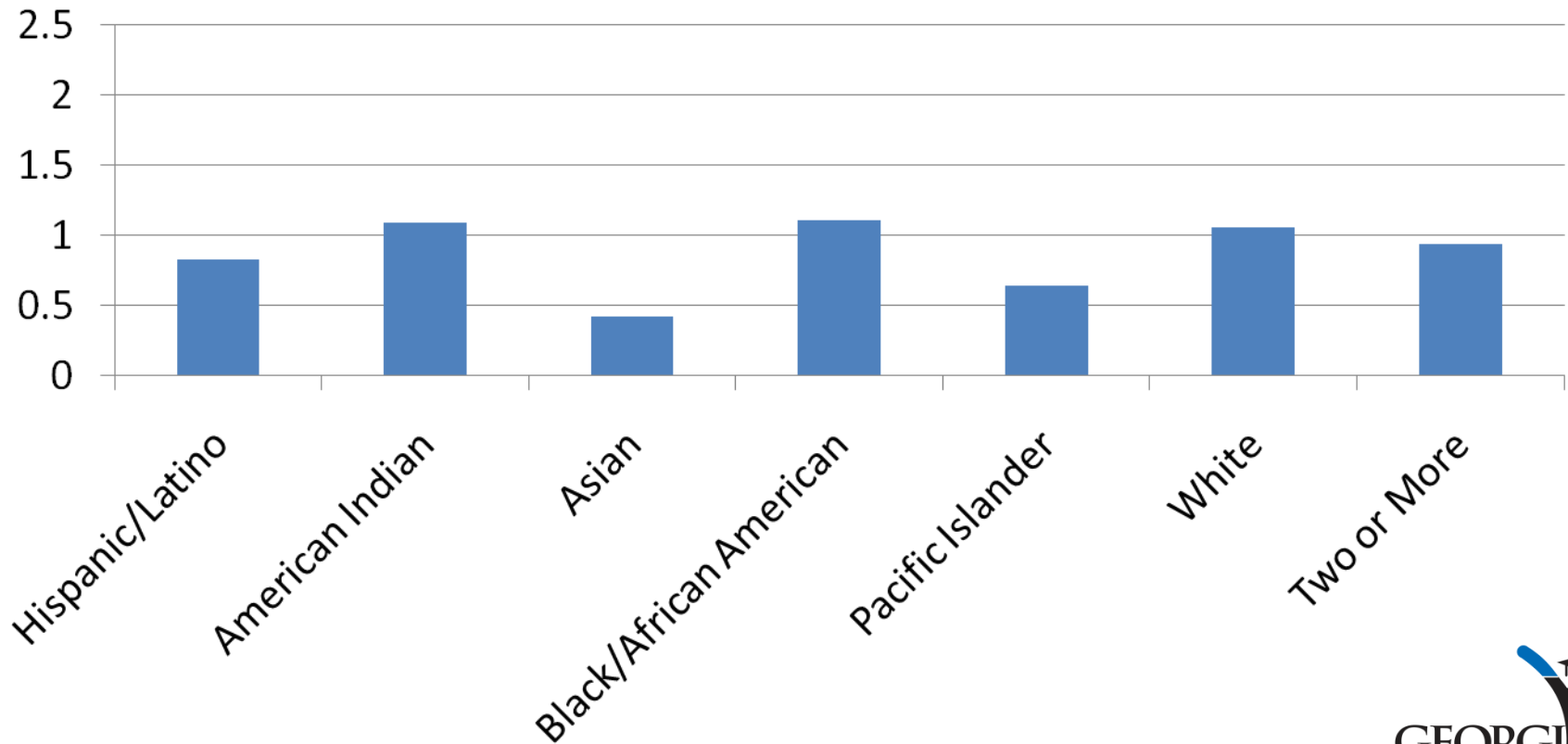

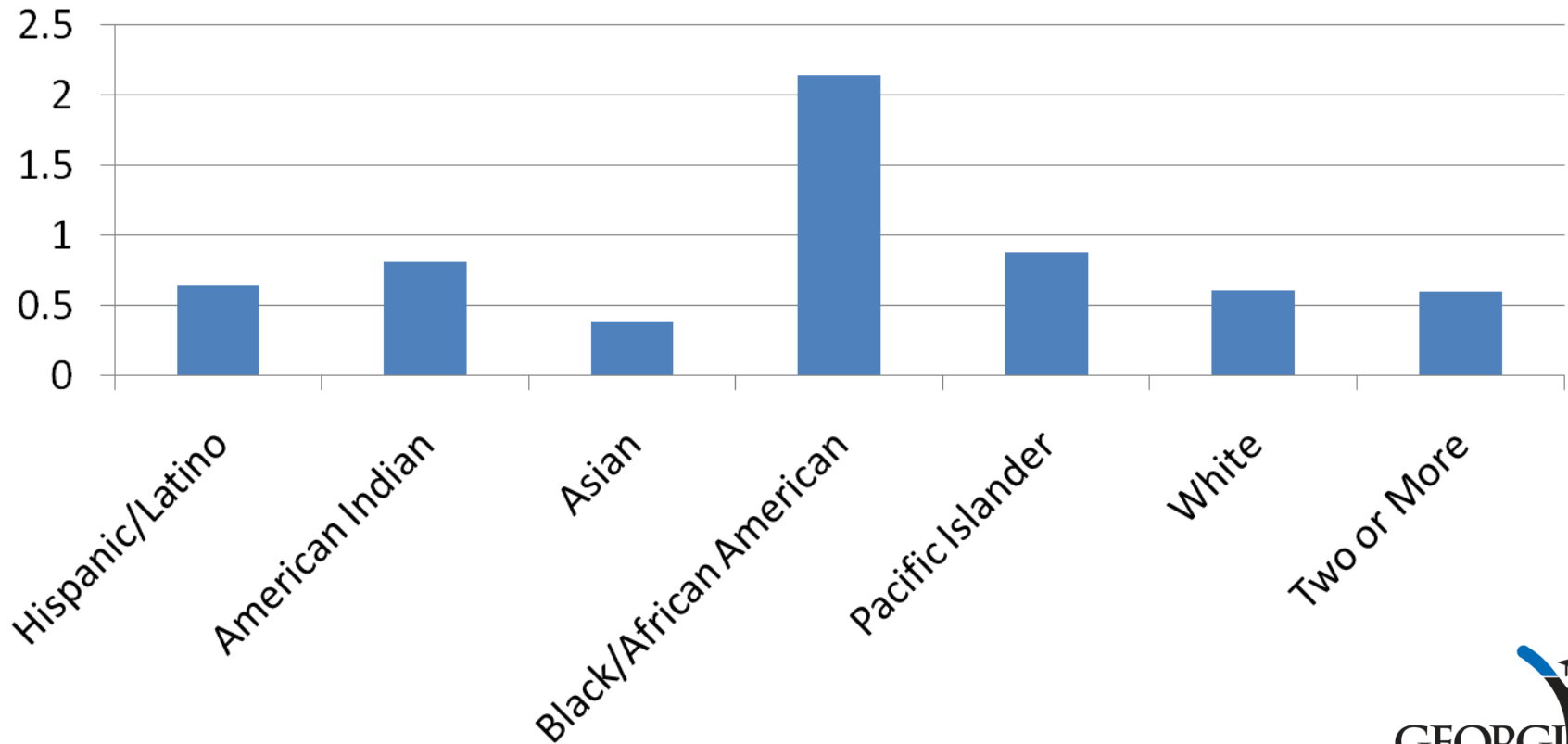

# Requirements for Significant Disproportionality for Discipline

- Incidence
- Duration
- Type
- Including suspension and expulsion



# Minimally Must Address

- Out-of-school (OSS) of 10 days or less
- OSS (including expulsions) > 10 days
- In-school suspension (ISS) of 10 days or less
- ISS > 10 days
- Total number of disciplinary removals

# Total Disciplinary Removals

- Events per student ratio (EPSR) was used in assessing disproportionality in total disciplinary removals.

# Georgia Hybrid Duration and Type

- Unduplicated count of SWD with OSS+ISS totaling >10 days.
- FY10 will be the final year for the Georgia Hybrid. Does not address all five Office of Special Education Programs (OSEP) required areas.
- Districts were informed in October 2008 that both in-school and out-of-school suspension influence Significant Disproportionality.

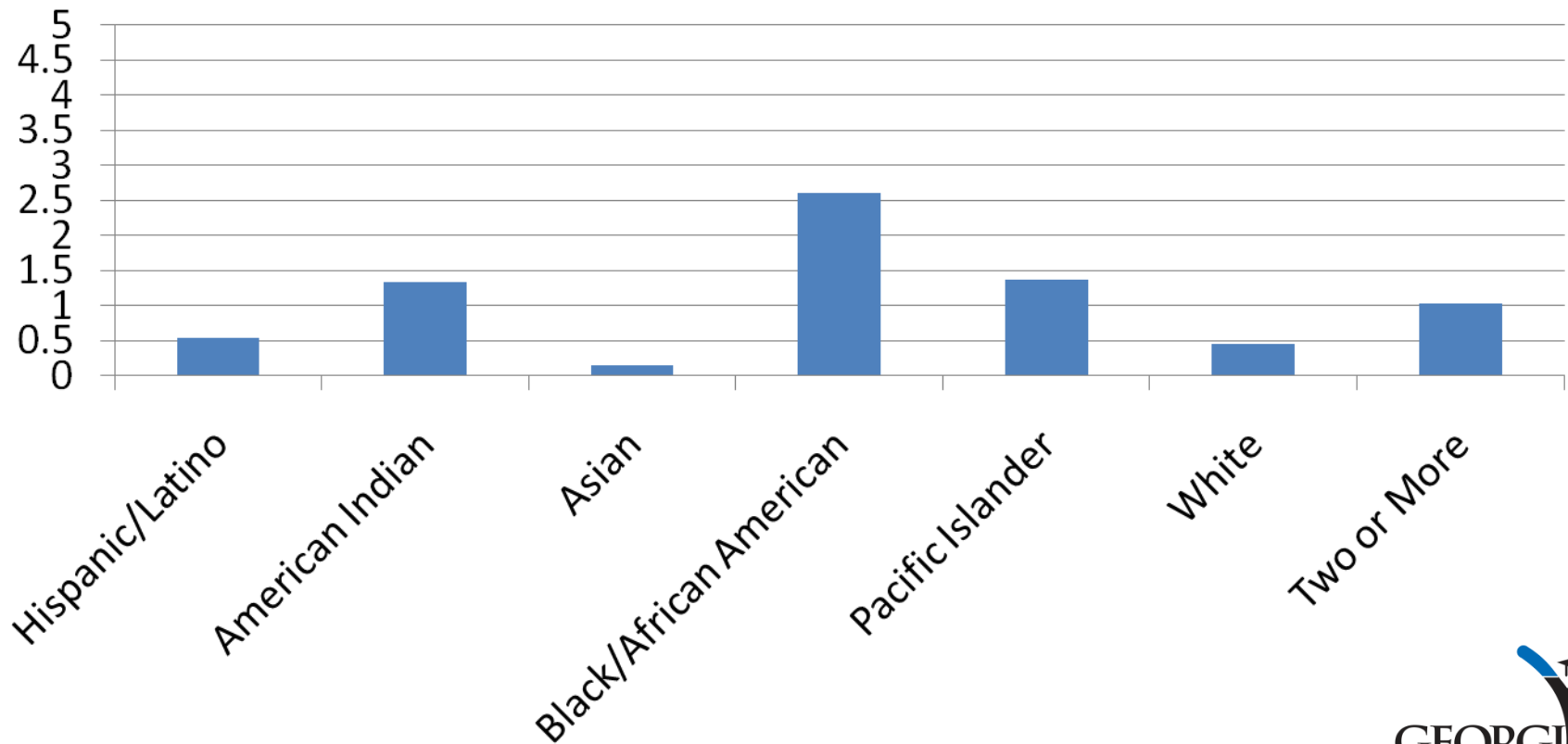

Events Per Student Ratio

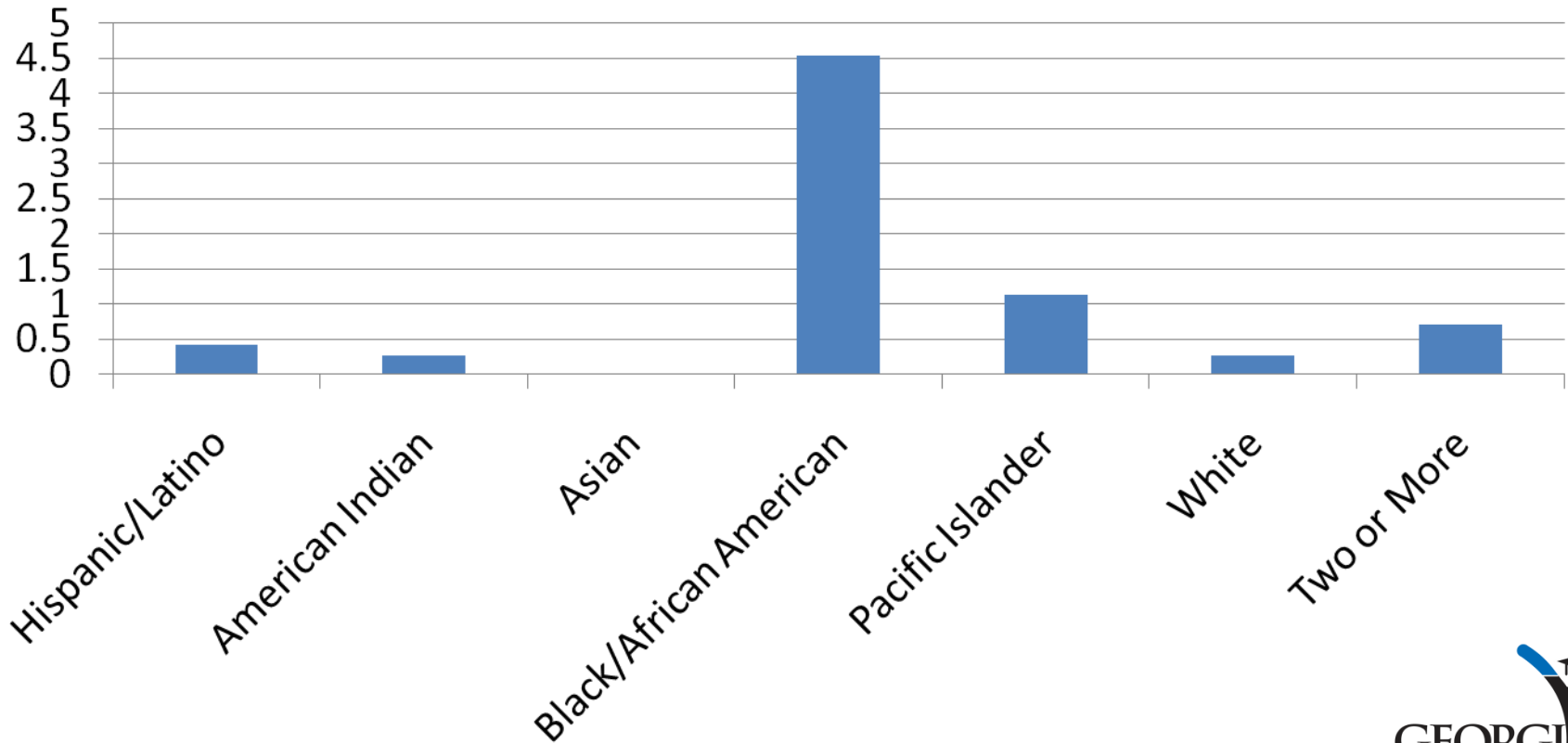

# Requirements for Significant Discrepancy for Discipline

<p>Rates of suspension and expulsion:</p> <p>A. Percent of districts that have a significant discrepancy in the rate of suspensions and expulsions of greater than 10 days in a school year for children with IEPs; and</p>	<p>B. Percent of districts that have:</p> <p>(a) a significant discrepancy, by race or ethnicity, in the rate of suspensions and expulsions of greater than 10 days in a school year for children with IEPs; and</p> <p>(b) policies, procedures or practices that contribute to the significant discrepancy and do not comply with requirements relating to the development and implementation of IEPs, the use of positive behavioral interventions and supports, and procedural safeguards.</p>

# Federal Data Report

- Data collected on Table 5 of Information Collection 1820-0621 (Report of Children with Disabilities Unilaterally Removed or Suspended/Expelled for More than 10 Days).
- Discrepancy can be computed by either comparing the rates of suspensions and expulsions for children with Individualized Education Programs (IEPs) to rates for nondisabled children within the Local Education Agency (LEA) or by comparing the rates of suspensions and expulsions for children with IEPs among LEAs within the State.
